TWO PRIMARY TYPES OF MISSION SUPPORT

Through the vision and leadership of the Presbytery Council, each congregation partners in ministry with the Presbytery through **General Shared Mission Support**. Our **General Shared Mission Support** is vital to providing for the ongoing pastoral and administrative leadership that makes possible the ministries and services of our presbytery. This includes funds that support the various ministry teams, educational scholarships and grants, leadership retreats, training for pastors, Asian and Hispanic Enrichment along with the leadership and administrative support of most of the presbytery staff. We are blessed to have a committed paid leadership team that honors the stewardship of the resources we've been blessed with.

In addition to our General Shared Mission Support, sessions are able to direct a portion of their giving to a specific ministry project and/or PCUSA missionary personnel through **Directed Mission Support**. Since the dollars used to support Directed Mission projects are budgeted, we can only spend the amount allocated. Thus, it is necessary to know in advance what amount will be directed toward a particular project in a particular year. Amounts that exceed the budgeted allocation *may* be re-directed to a similar project, with session consent.
