Presbytery of San Gabriel
Stated Meeting June 17, 2017

ASSEMBLE IN GOD'S NAME

The Presbytery of San Gabriel convened on Saturday, June 17, 2017 at 9:00 am. at San Marino Community Church of San Marino. A quorum was present as reflected in the roll. Moderator, Elder Fried Wilson opened the meeting with prayer; Teaching Elder Diane Frasher served as clerk. Teaching Elder Jeff O'Grady welcomed the Presbytery.

Moderator, Elder Fried Wilson moderated the meeting.

Commission on Preparation for Ministry

The Commission on Preparation for Ministry met on Tuesday, May 2, 2017 at Community, San Marino; a quorum was present.

ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE COMMITTEE

TE Dave Tomlinson reported for the committee.

TE Tomlinson reported the property location on Dalton – the realtor has lowered the lease price in

hopes of attracting a renter.

Irwindale is under contract but has been delayed due to a notice from the County of Los Angeles regarding earthquake-retrofitting that has never been completed.

South Hills – Two churches and two developers have shown active interest in the property. There have been some issues with vandalism and the Administration and Finance Committee is considering lowering the price on the property in order to facilitate a quick sale.

Action Requested

TE Dave Tomlinson, chair of the Administration and Finance Committee, moved that the Corporation of San Gabriel Presbytery be authorized to enter into a "Restoring Creation/Accessibility Loan" with Presbyterian Investment and Loan Program up to the maximum amount for such loans (\$350,000), and that the officers of the Presbytery Corporation are authorized to sign any and all loan documents.

The motion was seconded and approved.

Background

This loan was anticipated in the purchase of the Presbytery Center site in Temple City. The loan will provide for needed repairs and upgrades that will save energy and improve accessibility for the sanctuary and buildings, with a 1% discount on interest. Planned work includes:

- new roof and solar panels on the Fellowship Hall building
- replacement windows in the sanctuary, as needed
- building of an accessible restroom in the sanctuary building and conversion of office bathrooms to be more accessible
- replacement/repair of the heating/air conditioning and sound systems in the Sanctuary building
- Updating of the entire electrical system in the Sanctuary building.

EXECUTIVE COMMISSION

The San Gabriel Presbytery Executive Commission met on May 9, 2017, with a quorum present, and gives the following report.

RECOMMENDATIONS FOR PRESBYTERY APPROVAL

1. Upon recommendation of the Vision and Strategy Team, the Executive Commission voted to recommend that Presbytery provide a grant of \$7,908 to be distributed for June-August 2017 to Church Glorious through the Vision and Strategy Team. The grant would allow financial support for organizing pastor Rev. Kerry Allison for three months, as well as financial support for Sound/Music and Events, Social Media and an assistant. Funds will come from an account designated for Church Growth and Renewal. This item will be presented as part of the Vision and Strategy report to the Presbytery on June 17, 2017.
2. The Executive Commission voted to nominate Rev. Angel de Rosas to the Committee on Representation and Nominations, Class of 2019. This item will be presented as part of the Committee on Representation and Nominations report to the Presbytery on June 17, 2017.

DECISIONS MADE ON BEHALF OF THE PRESBYTERY

3. Glendale Korean Presbyterian Church currently has a three-person Administrative Commission, but one person, Rev. David Chai, resigned as he has moved back to Colorado. On behalf of the Presbytery, the Executive Commission voted to add Rev. Dongwoo Lee to the AC. In addition, the Executive Commission voted to authorize COM Moderator Cyndie Crowell to appoint two more members for the Administrative Commission and to report those names to the June Presbytery Meeting. The two ruling elders of the church, and the pastor, were added to the commission:

FOR INFORMATION

4. Contribution Statements – For individuals contributing funds to the Presbytery through offerings or other monetary donations, a contribution statement has been prepared and will be made available on an honor system at the clerk's table at presbytery meetings, or through the Presbytery office for donations between meetings.
5. The property on Dalton Street in Azusa has been prepared for lease. There was a question from a potential lessee that the second floor be subleased. It was approved that subleasing of the second floor be allowed as long as the primary lessee remain responsible for the full amount of the lease.
6. The property in Pomona for the former South Hills church is on the market, but has been subject to vandalism. A former member of the church, Don Sevesind, has been visiting and making repairs to the property as needed. The Trustees of the Presbytery has compensated him for this. When the property is sold, one third of the proceeds will go to a new church development that continues the legacy of South Hills, and \$1,000,000 will be used to pay down the loan on the Temple City property.
7. First Presbyterian Church Rosemead has moved to their new building in La Puente. They are vetting a new name, Puente de Esperanza (Bridge of Hope).
8. The Irwindale property is in escrow and should close some time in June. A gift of at least \$50,000 will be given to Mideast Evangelical Church to offset some of the funds they invested in the Irwindale property. \$600,000 will go back into the Presbytery's reserves, to replenish what was used for the down payment on Temple City.
9. The Temple City property at 9723 Garibaldi Avenue has closed escrow and is now owned by the Presbytery, thanks to PILP staff in approving and funding the loan in a very short period of time. The presbytery office has moved into the property, thanks to the heroic efforts of Twila French and the rest of the staff.
10. The Executive Commission discussed plans for the June 17th Work Day. The offering that day will go to the Tapestry Youth Collective, who will join the Presbytery for the Work Day.

REPRESENTATION AND NOMINATIONS COMMITTEE

TE Rob Crowell reported for the committee.
